SpeakUp! is a nonprofit 501 (c)(3) that supports young people as they navigate their journey to adulthood by BOTH helping young people talk honestly about their worries, concerns, and challenges to important adults in their lives AND positioning adults to better listen, guide, and support them.

We offer a school-based, youth-led program in over 30 middle and high schools in the Greater Philadelphia area and New Jersey. Here, youth, parenting adults, and school adults come TOGETHER to talk openly about topics the youth want to discuss. We complement this with our "Continue the Conversation" series which gives adults more chances to learn skills and gain confidence in talking about these same topics.

Our Programs



Our School-Based Program engages youth, school adults, and parenting adults together in supportive conversations.



Students join their **Student Leadership Team** to choose topics for their SpeakUp! event and build communication skills.



School adults attend our professional development to gain skills and confidence to facilitate challenging conversations.



The **SpeakUp! Event** brings students, school adults, and parenting adults together in breakout sessions on these topics.

Our Community-Based Continue the Conversation Programs enable adults to develop the skills to discuss challenging topics with young people.



Parenting Adult and Grandparent Coffees allow participants to discuss relevant topics and gain support and strategies.



Youth Mental Health First Aid Trainings teach participants how to identify and help someone experiencing a mental health crisis.



QPR Suicide Prevention Trainings provide parenting adults and school adults with innovative, practical, and proven strategies.
